OT Predicted the Virgin Birth Old Testament Prophecy

Isaiah 7:14

¹⁴“Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.

NT, Matthew Claims that this prophecy was fulfilled literally by Christ.

RSV translates “young woman” What a “sign”

Angel told Mary, Luke 1:34, “How can this be since I am a virgin?”

¹⁶All Scripture is ***inspired by God*** and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

“Inspiration” = God Breathed

“Verbal” = The Words

The Words of Scripture are inspired, not just the thoughts, concepts, ideals, the very words.

“Plenary” = All the Words

Ezekiel 3:16 is just as inspired as John 3:16
